Welcome to Anne Marie and Camille's hidden paradise. Located on the reef side of a motu (islet), close to the main pass of the island, a 5mn boat distance from the village, the Kuriri benefits from an ongoing breeze blowing from the open sea along with an outstanding view of the whales passing by from June to October. The property features bungalows scattered from sea to wilder view and are made from homegrown materials (bamboos, wood, coconut palms for roofs) along with a touch of oriental furniture. Thumbs up to the brilliant native hostesses providing such an excellent table to please all types of guests.

Location

The pension is reachable by boat only (return transfers done by the pension)
5 minutes boat from the main dock within the village and the main grocery stores
10 minutes boat to the airport
Located south from the main island, on Motu Tiapaa, 10km from the airport
Close to the Manta Ray cleaning station and the main pass of the island

Dining - Entertainment Features

The mandatory half board includes a continental breakfast and a dinner.

Meals are served in two different area:

Observatory area

Right on the seashore, gives a perfect view of the open sea and the reef
Breakfast table located underneath the observatory. Provides the same view but from the grown
Breakfast at 07:00 am: Coffee, tea, bread, fruit jelly, home made patisseries, fresh local fruits
Lunch available around noon: to be reserved in the morning and paid on the spot
Choice between light sandwiches or fish or meat preparation, according to availability

Dining Room

Separate Open area which also includes a lounge, or library facing the shore
Camille & Anne-Marie join their guests for dinner around a large cosmopolite table
Dinner at 7:00 pm: Fine steamed or grilled fish preparation, homegrown vegetables or rice, house made patisseries for dessert

Red & white wine available on request
No official bar
Wine, beer, punch and soft drinks are available on request

Facilities and Activities

Free wifi connection available from the main lounge area

In addition to the free activities listed, other sources of entertainment can be found such as:

- Discovery of the reef fauna & flora in front of the pension
- Experience the Manta Rays cleaning station, located within the lagoon, 15minutes paddling distance
- Get the chance to observe the whales in the open sea during the season from June to October

Paying activities on request

- Experience a traditional Tahitian oven on Sundays (ahimaa)
- Transfers to the main island to visit the village
- Guided hiking tours on the main island
- Motu excursions
- Excursion to the coral garden
- 1/2 day excursion : Approx 26 Euros / pers

Free activities: Fishing, Kayaks, Canoe, Library, Petanque, Snorkeling Equipment

Children

While the pension is not ideally suited for big families with children, one bungalow can host a family with children. Equipment such as snorkeling gear are provided. No other facilities are provided specifically for kids.

The establishment belongs to the official category of "pensions & family hotels." The classification of these lodges has been set in order to clearly differentiate them from the "international hotels and residences" category, based on the following key elements:

- A limited number of furnished units, generally located beside the family home
- Facilities tailored to domestic standards, different from the international tourist hotels criteria
- Restricted catering service
- Limited number of professionally trained personnel
- Reduced taxes

Bungalow & Half Board

Traditional type bungalow, built with natural materials, woven bamboo, wood and stone. Each unit is different with its own style but each of those include a comfortable living area.

Bungalow "Fare Pilotis": bedroom with 1 double bed

Bungalow "Fare Ovale": bedroom with 1 double bed

Bungalow "Fare Yoga": bedroom with 1 twin bed

Bungalow "Fare Ora": 1 bedroom with 1 double bed + possibility for 2 children to sleep in the upper loft + 1 children in the sofa

Maximum Occupancy: 2A or 3A or 4A

Bed Configuration: 1 double bed or 1 double bed + 1 single bed or 2 double beds
