PRESENTATION

The most beautiful REGATTA in the South Pacific

The Tahiti Pearl Regatta, or "TPR," has been one of the most beautiful, festive spirit and highly-publicized years in the Pacific islands since 2004.

It's organized every year in one of the loveliest sailing areas in the world, in the heart of French Polynesia.

The Tahiti Pearl Regatta is bringing together some 40 local and international crews for 5 days of racing and festivities.

A Traveling REGATTA

The Tahiti Pearl Regatta takes place in the Leeward Islands, there will be races around and in the lagoons of Raiatea and Taha'a. Every evening, the crews return to anchor in front of Motu Mahaea in Taha'a, and gather on the beach for theme nights.

The TPR asserts its festive atmosphere and its Polynesian identity, offering crews cultural events and sharing time: blessing of the skippers, dance shows, Polynesian food buffets and awards evening ceremony during which people can dance all around until the middle of the night, with toes in the sand and head in the stars.

AROUND THE RACE

RACE Categories

The race is open to all types of sailboats, with no size limitations (monohulls, catamarans, trimarans, private or charter sailboats, transpacific stopovers, sailing canoes, support boats, etc.), and follows WS racing rules. Crews may enroll in one of the following categories:

- MONOHULL RACING (Division 1 or 2) for monohulls with an HN Osiris rating certificate
- MULTIHULL RACING for boats with a Multi2000 certificate
- OUTRIGGER SAILING CANOES
- LIGHT SAILING
- CRUISING for boats without a certificate.

A festive REGATA

Every afternoon, after the sporting stages, the racers are invited to join the anchorage in front of the base camp. It's time for the «third half-time» of the race; time to relax and debrief with the crew. From 6:30 pm onwards, shuttles ensure transfers between the boats and the motu (islet). On land, the participants can enjoy a drink together, followed by a dinner and a festive evening.

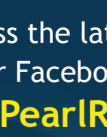
Boats registered for Racing will be scored based on their corrected time, those in the Cruising category based on their real time.

The boats in the "Cruising" category will only participate in the 3 afternoons races (C2, C4 and C6).
