The Tahiti Pearl Regatta takes place


in the Leeward Islands, there will

A festive **REGATA** Every afternoon, after the sporting stages,

the racers are invited to join the anchorage in front of the base camp. It's time for the «third half-time» of the race; time to relax and debrief with the crew. From 6:30 pm onwards, shuttles ensure transfers between the boats and the motu (islet). On land, the participants can enjoy a drink together, followed by a dinner and a festive evening.
